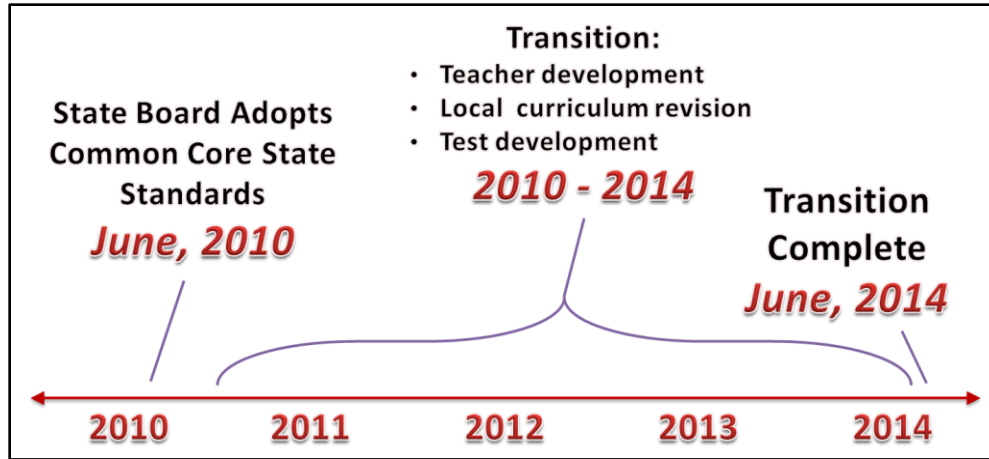


Common Core State Standards Implementation Timeline for Oklahoma Public Schools

July 6, 2010 – Governor Brad Henry Approved Adoption
